While attending the Western Area Rally in Indio, I spoke with some representatives from the Los Angeles office of Aon Recreation Insurance. Aon, the original creator of specialty RV insurance, has been a commercial member of FMCA since 1966.

Aon said they wanted to do something new and exciting for our members. During February, Aon will pay for a one-year chapter membership (up to \$10) per "F" number, for the first 1,000 members that call for an insurance quote on their coach. Members belonging to multiple chapters are only eligible for one free \$10 chapter membership for a year.

We also discussed the possibility of some non-chapter members wanting the \$10 in cash. This defeats the purpose of Chapter growth, so Aon will make it known that the \$10 is only redeemable for one year of free chapter membership. Every FMCA member who is currently an Aon customer is eligible for a free chapter membership too. They just need to call and receive an insurance quote on another line such as auto, home or motorcycle. Please note, members must **call** Aon's offices Monday-Friday 6am-4pm PST in order to get chapter membership dues paid. This offer is **not** available on Aon's website.

The Northwest Area is the very first to have this opportunity. This is an excellent way for us to see some chapter membership growth. Aon is also offering to spend some well-needed sponsorship money on our Northwest Area Rally in Albany this June.

Please forward this email and share the news with all your chapter members and non-chapter friends. This is an opportunity for you to have your dues paid, while gaining high quality insurance coverage for your RV.
